



DUCK SEASON

The 2016spring survey of North American breeding ducks carried out by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and Canadian Wildlife Service elded a populationestimate of 48.4 rhion breeding birds in the traditional survey area, coparable to 2015's record estimate of 49.5 million birds. What have duck numbers been ke at Rio Bosque Wetlands Park this fall and winter? After a brief dry spell, water deliveries to the park from the Roberto Bustamante Wastewater Treatment Plant resumed October 23. For several weeks, few waterds arrived, but that changed with codleweather. With 2,0002,500 ducks currently wintering at Rio Bosque, tis a great time to visithe park

including 1.5 miles next to Rio Bosque. The work has been takinglace in fall and winter to avoid the irrigation season.

Segments completed in prior years inclu600feet along the park's east boundary in 200094,370 feet largely along the park's south boundary in 2010-and ~3,280 feet upstream of the bridge at the entrance to the Jonathan Rogers and Roberto-Busta mante watertreatment plants in 20156. This winter, El Paso #1 is lining 1,600 feet immediately downstream of the bridge.

In 2017, El Paso #1 plans to seek additional funding to complete the project. If successful, it intends to line the final ~6,150 eet, including 4,230 feet along the park's east boundary, next fall and winter.
